All applicants must include a cover letter, resume and a minimum of three references. The cover letter should state why you have chosen to apply for an internship with St. Ann's and what you want to gain from the experience.

We realize that students may have limited work experience, but please remember to list all relevant work experience (customer service, volunteer experiences, leadership roles in group activities, etc.), training, and education.
